1. Written test for the purpose of 20% Internal Assessment will also be conducted in all Theory Papers in respect of the students of B.A. Part-I, II & III classes during last two days of PCP.
2. Since the PCPs are conducted for the benefit of the DDE students and as mentioned in the Prospectus **50% attendance in the PCP is COMPULSORY** to become eligible to appear in the University examinations, you are advised to attend the PCP classes regularly. No exemption from attending the PCP will be allowed. **No change of PCP centre/batch will be entertained in any case.**
3. The candidates are also advised to pay the balance fee/2<sup>nd</sup> installment and submit the deficient documents, if any, immediately to confirm the eligibility for appearing in the University examination failing which you will not be allowed to appear in the University examinations.
4. The students will have to make their own arrangements for their boarding and lodging during the course of the PCP. However, at Kurukshetra there are a number of 'Dharamshalas' and 'Yatri Niwas' of Haryana Tourism with mess facilities on the main road near the University which can be contacted for the purpose.  
The written response-sheets for the students of B.A. Part-I, II & III during this session i.e. 2014-15 are not compulsory, the students in their own interest are also advised to submit written response-sheets on topics concerning their course for evaluation by the teachers.

**Note:** The Annual Examination of undergraduates courses will tentatively commence on 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2015, if any candidate does not receive his/her Admit Card/Roll No. slip in time, he/she should contact the Director with three passport size photographs for issue of duplicate Roll No. Slip/Admit Card.
