<b>3. All second- and third-year classes are promotional, and students will be provisionally promoted subject to the condition of passing all reappear exams in the permissible chances as per rules.</b>
<b>4. All programmes shall be passed within the stipulated duration.</b>
<b>5. Learners shall fulfill the requirements of concerned programmes well in time as mentioned in the prospectus regarding PCPs, Exams, reports, assignments etc.</b>
<b>6. Learners shall check website of CDOE for regular updates and shall also log in to their IUMS dashboard for any information. It is their responsibility to check their registered emails and phones regularly for any updates from CDOE</b>

## DETAILS OF PROGRAMMES

### TRADITIONAL PROGRAMMES

#### 1. BACHELOR OF ARTS-BA (3-YEAR SEMESTER SYSTEM UNDER NEP 2020)- SEMESTER I

BA Sem. 1	Fresh Admission as per eligibility
BA Sem. 2-6	Promotional Classes (No fresh admission needed). Students are provisionally promoted
BA- III (Annual)	Promotional Classes (No fresh admission needed). Students are provisionally promoted

#### Minimum Eligibility Conditions for Admission to first year of the programme

A candidate who has passed Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (Class XII level) of the Board of School Education, Haryana; or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with minimum passing marks in aggregate with English as one of the subjects, shall be eligible to join First Semester of the Undergraduate (UG) Programme.

**OR**

A candidate having 2-Year Diploma from ITI or 3-Year Diploma from Polytechnic of minimum 2 years duration qualified with Hindi Core/English as one subject or as an additional subject at Class XII level is also eligible for seeking admission in First Semester of the UG Programme in Arts discipline or in the disciplines wherever mentioned so.

#### Medium of Instructions and Examination

For Arts/ Commerce subjects, the medium of instructions shall be Hindi/English. The question paper shall be set in both English and Hindi, wherever feasible, except in the case of

- English, in which the questions shall be set in English.
- Sanskrit, in which the questions shall be set in Sanskrit/Hindi.
- Other languages, in which the questions shall be set in the language concerned.

The students shall write their answers:

- i. in English, in case of English language
- ii. in the language concerned, in the case of Modern Indian Languages
- iii. English/Hindi in the case of other subjects.

### **Duration of Programme**

A student can complete a Bachelor degree programme within seven years. A student who fails to pass the whole examination(s) of a UG programme within seven years of admission to the programme, shall be awarded Undergraduate Certificate/Diploma on the basis of qualified courses as per credit point, if eligible

### **Conditions for Promotion to Higher Semester and Rules for Re-appear**

A student who has appeared and failed in one or more courses of the First Semester shall be allowed to study for and appear in the second semester. Such a student may pursue her/his studies for the next higher semester(s) and appear in the examination(s) for the same along with the examination for the lower semester(s).

### **Internship**

Every student for the UG Programme shall be required to undergo 4 credit internship of 4-6 weeks duration before taking an exit or completing the degree programme.

A student for the UG Programme shall be required to undergo internship during summer vacation either after the second semester examination or after the fourth semester examination. If s/he opts to exit with Undergraduate Certificate in the discipline, then it shall be obligatory to complete the internship after second semester examination. However, for those students who have taken lateral entry into the third semester and have completed internship of 4-6 weeks duration during first year, the internship is not required after the fourth semester examination

### 3. B.A. (GENERAL) (3-YEAR) PART-III- Annual

#### Eligibility conditions

Pass in B.A.(General) Part-I/Part-II examination, under 10+2+3 scheme of Kurukshetra University or of another University, the B.A. (General) Part-I/Part-II examination under open stream of this University or any other University which is recognized as equivalent to B.A.(General) examination of this University, or other programmes of Integrated nature (4/5 years) provided that the subjects studied by the candidate are the same as are available in B.A.- I & II (Annual system) at Kurukshetra University and the candidate is otherwise eligible.

#### Programmes of study and schemes of examinations

COMPULSORY/ELECTIVE PAPERS as already taken in B.A. Part-I/II will be the same in BA-III respectively opted by the candidate from Grouping given of this Prospectus.

Apart from the subjects taken in the B.A. Part-I/II, the candidate may opt the following options in B.A. Part-III

#### NOTE

1. The Centre would supply the Study Material for History (Option-ii) Modern World. In case any candidate selects Option(i) Ancient and Medieval World or Option (iii) East Asia in Modern Times, he/she would have to prepare the concerned subject at his/her own level and NO STUDY MATERIAL WOULD BE PROVIDED FOR THE SAME BY THE CENTRE.
2. Candidates joining B.A. Part/III are required to opt for same subjects which they have opted in B.A. Part-I and II respectively.
3. For subjects having practical, the candidates are required to submit a certificate from a recognized College/institution to the effect that they have completed the programme prescribed for practical work in the subject concerned. This certificate must reach the Centre by 31 Oct 2026/28 February, 2026, failing which Roll No. slips shall not be issued to the students.

#### **Compulsory qualifying subject of environmental studies (BA/BCA/B.Com. -old annual scheme)**

The candidates seeking admission to the BA/B.Com./BCA Part-I programme will also have to opt the Compulsory Qualifying subject of Environmental Studies and they will have to qualify the same OTHERWISE THE FINAL RESULT WILL NOT BE DECLARED.

The programme on the subject of Environmental Studies carries 100 marks and includes both Theory and Field work (Practical) as under:

<b>Paper-I</b>	<b>Theory</b>	<b>75 marks</b>
Part “A”	Short Answer Pattern	25 Marks
Part “B”	Essay Type including choice	50 Marks
<b>Paper II*</b>	Field work (practical)	25 Marks

Note: CDOE students will appear in the same examination conducted by the University for Theory Papers along with other students of above mentioned programmes.

\*The objective of the field work is to provide first-hand knowledge to students on various local environmental aspects on the basis of their:

- Visit to local area to document environmental assets river/forest/grassland/hill/ mountain.
- Visit to a local polluted site - Urban/Rural/Industrial/Agricultural
- Study of common plants, insects, birds.
- Study of simple ecosystems-pond, river, hill slopes, etc.
- Minimum pass marks is 35% both in Theory as well as Field Work (Practical) independently. However, marks obtained by them in this qualifying paper will not be counted for determining the percentage of marks/division obtained by them for the award of the “Degree”. The

marks obtained by the candidates in this subject will be reflected in the Detailed Marks Certificate.

The candidates who will not be able to pass in the subject of Environmental Studies (Theory and/or Field Work (Practical) in 1st year will have to qualify the same by appearing in the examination in 2nd year or 3rd year or thereafter by submitting a separate examination form and examination fee of Rs. 50/- as an ex-student as in the case of Reappear/Compartment candidates. There will, however, be no supplementary examination in the subject of Environmental Studies.

The students of the Centre for Distance and Online Education who have to appear in the paper of Environmental Studies are required to submit their Project Report of around 20 pages to the Principal of the concerned College on the scheduled date examination of the said paper. The students will also pay a fee of Rs.50/- by each to the Principal of the concerned College on account of conduct of their examination in the subject of Environmental Studies.

Candidates who are placed under compartment in the qualifying examination **shall be allowed provisional admission to Previous/Part-I of any Master's degree or Advanced Graduate Diploma programme.** However, such candidates shall pass the compartment subject in the supplementary examination before the commencement of first semester/ first year examination of the concerned programme.
2. All programmes of CDOE have promotional system. Students will be automatically promoted to the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> years of the programme and they can appear in the lower-class examinations alongwith higher level class examinations. All reappear exams have to be passed within permissible chances as per rules.

Pass in 12th/10+2 examination from the Board of School Education, Haryana or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto.
